However, as many businesses have been required by Government to remain closed during lockdown, regular testing and maintenance schedules may have been disrupted. Add to this, changes in temperature and humidity, as heating systems have been reduced to a minimum whilst buildings are unoccupied, and some faults may have crept into the system.

The 'Responsible Person' should review the Fire Risk Assessment to ensure it takes into account any changes to business operations due to Coronavirus. It is also advisable to contact your service provider to check their service is not affected by the pandemic, and if it is, you will need to make adjustments to your fire safety system.
